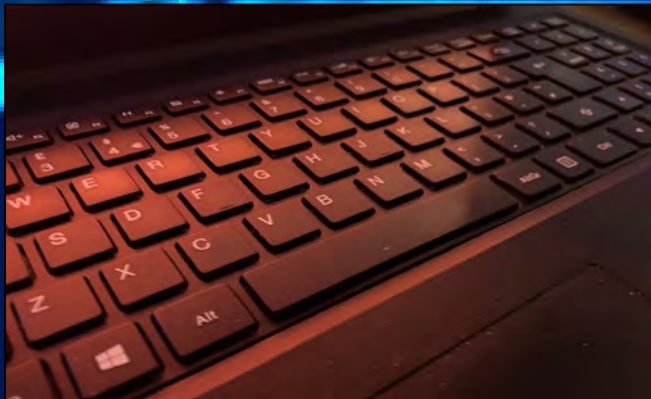


Why study A Level Computer Science at Tarporley Sixth Form?
