# **YEAR 6 TRANSITION RESIDENTIAL**

The Conway Centre is a large residential facility set in idyllic surroundings on the Isle of Anglesey, North Wales. The centre's grounds extend down to the Menai Straits and include parkland, gardens, a private dock and adventure playgrounds.

# Why are we going to the Conway Centre?

We are going to the Conway Centre so that you can meet and make friends with children from other schools, who will also be joining Tarporley High School in September 2025. You will get to know your new form tutor, your Year Leader and also some of the members of your new tutor group. You will also get to know some of the other teachers from the High School who will be making sure that your move from Year 6 to Year 7 goes smoothly.

# Who will be going to the Conway Centre?

All the children who will join Tarporley High School in September 2025 have been invited. This will include children from all the schools in the surrounding area and also some students who are moving to live in the Tarporley area. You will all largely be accompanied by your Primary School teachers too, so you will have lots of staff looking after you over the three days.

# **Pocket Money**

If you would like to bring some pocket money with you, then you need to make sure that you look after it - this will be your responsibility. There will be a tuck shop, from which sweets, drinks and small souvenirs may be purchased. You will only need a little pocket money: we suggest a maximum of £10.00.

#### **Medicines**

If you are taking medicine, an administering medication form will need to be completed and handed to your teacher along with all medicines.

# What do I need to bring?

- I. A water bottle (which you can refill)
- 2. A small rucksack in which to carry everyday items
- 3. A watch
- 4. Soap, flannel, shampoo, toothbrush and toothpaste, comb or hairbrush (in an appropriate bag)
- 5. Towel
- 6. Sun hat & sun protection cream
- 7. Nightwear e.g. pyjamas or nightdress
- 8. Two pairs of jeans / everyday trousers, t-shirts
- 9. Warm sweater or sweatshirt
- 10. At least 3 pairs of spare socks
- 11. Changes of underwear
- 12. **Sensible** walking shoes or hiking boots, trainers
- 13. Indoor shoes
- 14. An old pair of trainers for the watersports
- 15. A long sleeved top for the watersports
- 16. Waterproof outdoor coat / cagoule
- 17. Tissues
- 18. P.E. equipment-shorts and t-shirt, trainers
- 19. Pens, pencils, crayons, ruler etc-in a pencil case.
- 20. A notebook
- 21. Book (for quiet reading)
- 22. A packed lunch for Wednesday in your small rucksack, this will go on the coach with you. Do not pack your lunch in your main bag/suitcase as this will be stored in the luggage boot on the bus.

IT MAY BE THAT YOU WILL DO WATERSPORTS IMMEDIATELY AFTER EATING YOUR LUNCH SO PLEASE PUT WATERSPORTS KIT IN A SEPARATE BAG AT THE TOP OF YOUR CASE!
