

Careers Events



Careers education continues to be delivered through weekly tutor sessions and half-termly PHSE mornings, with a number of events taking place this term.

During this half-term, students in years 7 through to 11 have received a careers assembly to introduce them to the new programme and introduce the theme and key events for their year group. Following on from this, during PHSE morning 1 on Tuesday 5th October careers sessions were delivered to year 7, year 10 and year 11.

Year 7

Following on from their introduction to careers education assembly, Year 7 were introduced to the concept of employability skills and to recognise how those skills are developed during their time at school. The students participated in a workshop delivered by Boost Employability Skills and afterwards students received an employability skills information pack and certificate.

Year 10

Students in year 10 had an assembly delivered by Mploy Solutions to launch work experience and afterwards students were provided with a preparation booklet and self-placement form. Students then participated in two further sessions, one to support them in deciding on possible placements and researching local businesses, and the other was an employability skills workshop delivered by Boost Life Skills. The focus here was for student to reflect on the skills they have and how they can be developed from undertaking work experience. Afterwards, students received an information pack and certificate. All information and documents regarding work experience, including the parent pack can be found in the work experience section of the school website. Year 10 work experience will take place from Monday 20th June to Friday 24th June.

Year 11

In supporting our year 11 students with their post-16 option choices, we ran a post-16 pathways morning where students were able to meet local further education providers. The autumn term is a key time for year 11 to consider their options and attend local college open events. More information on open events can be found on the Post-16 options page later in the newsletter.

During PHSE morning 2 on Tuesday 2nd November students in year 7, year 9 and year 11 will have careers sessions.

Year 7 will be introduced to the concept of labour market information and learn about the local area they live in and the industries they could work in.

Year 9 will participate in an enterprise morning delivered by Bright Futures. The session will introduce students to the key aspects of enterprise: risk-taking, managing change and having an entrepreneurial spirit. It will also reinforce the importance of having a positive attitude and help prepare them for the world of work.

Year 11 will participate in a CV workshop to support them in preparing for their mock interviews which will take place from Monday 6th December to Wednesday 8th December.

Post-16 Options



The decisions students make about their next steps, are very important ones. We are here to support all of our Year 11 students with making informed choices. Our Careers Adviser, Mrs Robson is continuing to provide careers guidance interviews all students in year 11 will have received at least one careers guidance interview by Christmas.



The advice given is impartial and always in the best interests of the young person.

Careers guidance interviews for students in lower year groups can be requested by students or parents through their tutor or year leader.

Open events

Tarporley High School 6th Form virtual open evening was held on Thursday 14th October and students have already had an assembly and Q&A session with members of the sixth form team.
