

Careers Encounters 2021-22



Y7-Y11 PSHE Morning encounters with employers and providers:

Year 7 students attended an Employability workshop delivered by Boost Life Skills

Year 8 students engaged with local employers' who introduced their businesses and their career pathways.

Year 9 students participated in an enterprise morning delivered by Bright Futures. Cheshire College delivered a session on Post-16 pathways talk and the introduction to T Levels. Students also met our school careers adviser and engaged in a career talk from Rebecca Zartarian from BlueBird Care.

Year 10 students attended an Employability Workshop delivered by Boost Life Skills, an Apprenticeship session from Ask Apprenticeships, a Post-16 talk from Cheshire College with introduction to T Levels, and they recently participated in CV workshop delivered by Youth Fed. One of our former students who is currently undertaking an apprenticeship with Ernest & Young, also delivered a career talk on the value of apprenticeships as a future pathway. Students engaged with local employers' who introduced their businesses and their career pathways.

Year 11 students participated in a Post 16 Pathways morning delivered by local colleges, our 6th form and Ask Apprenticeships.

6th form PSHE programme

Our 6th form students have participated in a career insights employer session, UCAS workshops and employability sessions. They have explored post-18 options of university and apprenticeships. Attended CV workshops and mock interview sessions.

Work experience

This year, we have been able to revert back to physical work experience with 106 Y12 students undertaking a week of work experience in March, and 204 Y10 students undertaking a week of work experience last week. The feedback from employers was excellent.

Year 11 Mock Interviews

In December, our Y11 students prepared for and attended mock interviews conducted by members of Tarporley Rotary Club. The students enjoyed the experience and received really valuable feedback.

Careers Adviser

Our school Careers Adviser Mrs Robson has continued to deliver careers guidance interviews for our students. All Year 11 students have received at least one interview to support them in making their post-16 options. Some of our Y9 students have also received an interview to support them in making their GCSE option choices. Currently, our Y10 and Y12 students are receiving careers guidance interviews.

Young Enterprise







All students will be awarded with a Work Experience Certificate for participating in the day. This is something that they can include in their UCAS and Apprenticeship Applications.

The next Work Experience day is on the **Sunday 31**st **July** and will cover the following healthcare careers:

The virtual work experience day will take place through an online portal and run LIVE from 10am-5pm, following 2 patients from their initial accidents through to recovery. Students will see them interact with a variety of healthcare professionals listed above so that they develop an understanding of the multidisciplinary team as well as insights into their own chosen career. Students will also have the opportunity to interact with the healthcare professionals via a LIVE Chat function and polls throughout the day!

The cost to attend is £10/student per session or £45 if you book all five sessions, which is just an administrative cost to cover the set-up of individual portals, personalised certificates, safeguarding, the technology on the day, such as our servers and chat functions.
