
Our careers programme

Our careers programme informs students of the range of pathways available and raises awareness of the workplace skills and careers relevant to curriculum subjects they study. As well as engaging and inspiring students in the world of work through employer and educational encounters and

Career related learning provides our students with a range of opportunities beyond the core curriculum which support their development so students are fully equipped for the next phase of their lives. Delivery through Aspire days, tutorial programme and curriculum areas, helps students understand the relationship between their own employability skills and the needs of the local labour market, whilst improving their career management skills.
