
## **Our careers programme**



Career Education, Information, Advice and Guidance (CEIAG) contributes to student achievement by raising aspirations, confidence and motivation. Our careers programme informs students of the range of pathways available and raises awareness of the workplace skills and careers relevant to curriculum subjects they study. As well as engaging and inspiring students in the world of work through employer and educational encounters and visits.

Career related learning provides our students with a range of opportunities beyond the core curriculum which support their development so students are fully equipped for the next phase of their lives. Delivery through Aspire days, tutorial programme and curriculum areas, helps students understand the relationship between their own employability skills and the needs of the local labour market, whilst improving their career management skills. Our careers programme allows students to see skill progression and empowers them to make informed choices at transition phases through impartial careers advice.

Our careers programme is as follows:



# **Y10 Virtual Work Experience**

Work Experience is a key part of our Y10 curriculum as it provides students with an opportunity, beyond the core curriculum, that supports their development to equip them for the next phase of their lives. The experience aims to raise aspirations, confidence and motivation by informing students of pathways available and raising awareness of workplace skills.

Due to the pandemic, students in Y10 were unable to undertake work experience in a physical work place. However, we felt it was important to provide students with a high-quality alternative. So, working with local employers and the Cheshire & Warrington Local Enterprise Partnership, students undertook 3 days of project based virtual work experience. The aims of virtual work experience were to:

- Increase student confidence
- Understand workplace behaviours/expectations
- Develop essential skills
- Get real-life experience of work via projects

- International construction company with projects in Chester
- Project: Design and cost a new bridge for a road development near Tarvin.

An exciting range of projects were provided by the employers.



During the 3 days, students worked under the supervision of the employer, communicating with them via Microsoft Teams. Students were allocated a job role and they worked as a team to produce a solution and meet the deadlines set. Employers met virtually with the students at the start of the 3 days to introduce the company and the project, they met again on the following morning to provide feedback and throw in a 'curve ball'. On the final morning, all groups presented back their solution to the employers and received fantastic feedback for all their hard work.

Overall, the experience was very positive, with students having the opportunity to reflect on their employability skills and identify on how the experience had enabled them to develop these essential skills. Student, staff and employer feedback was overwhelmingly positive and we have built relationships with employers who were extremely impressed with our students, and we look forward to working with them again on the future.





Employers were very encouraging and gave plenty of their time to help. The structure of the two days preparation was spot on; requirement for students to solve problems and think laterally and really work on those key skills was excellent.

Despite the fact the experience was virtual, the flexibility worked well as well as the demands on the time were managed well.


