There will be opportunities to attend workshops via Microsoft Teams and these will be delivered by The Autism Service Teachers. Workshops will include:

- supporting organisation and independence
- developing strategies to address emotional well-being
- supporting the communication needs of the young person

There will also be information provided by High School SENCOs focusing on effective joint parent/school working.

A virtual marketplace experience will be co-ordinated so that you can learn more about outside agency support, such as help provided by the National Autistic Society (NAS), Disability Positive (Originally CCIL), Cheshire Autism Practical Support (ChAPS) and the Independent Advice and Support Service (IASS).

You will receive a copy of The Autism Service Transition to High School Pack and this will be a useful tool to use with the child you are supporting both in school and at home.
